- [Funnel Pitchers](#)
- [46 x 4.5 ml \(.15 oz\) Frosted Bottles w/Treatment Pump*](#) or [7 x 1 oz Clear Bottles](#) w/ [7 x Disc Caps](#)

*The treatment pump bottles won't dispense a mist because this solution is too thick, but it will dispense the perfect small amount to use.

INGREDIENTS

- 3 oz [Sweet Almond Oil](#)
- 2 oz [Avocado Oil](#)
- 1 oz [Grapeseed Oil](#)
- 0.8 oz [Castor Oil](#)
- 0.15 oz [Natural Vitamin E Tocopherol](#)
- 0.20 oz [Fragrance Oil](#) or [Essential Oil](#)



DIRECTIONS

Step 1

Weigh out your oils and combine in a funnel pitcher.



Step 2

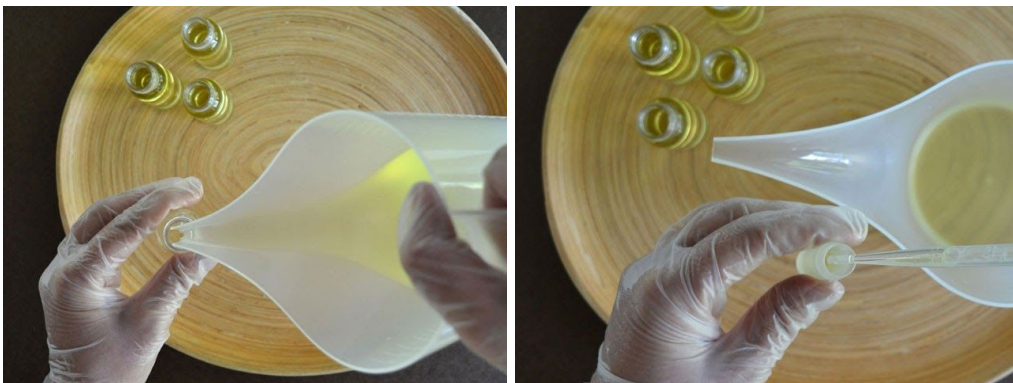
Add your fragrance and mix well.

Step 3

Pour into your bottles and label.

You won't need a preservative since this is an anhydrous formula (one that does not contain any water).



Here's how to label your beard oil:

Prunus Amygdalus Dulcis (Sweet Almond) Oil, Persea Gratissima (Avocado Oil), Prunus Vitis Vinifera (Grape) Seed Oil, Ricinus Communis (Castor) Seed Oil, Vitamin E Tocopherol, Fragrance
